The Government has adopted various laws and regulations to ensure that individuals with disabilities have equal access to opportunities and protections in all aspects of life. Among these: the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), the Rehabilitation Act, the Fair Housing Act, the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), the Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) program, and the Southwest ADA Center.







The Care Connection for Aging & Disability **Resource Center** (ADRC), is a collaboration between the Administration for Community Living, the **Centers for Medicare** and Medicaid Services. and the Veterans Health Administration. to streamline access to long-term services and supports for older adults, people with disabilities, and their families.
