The Houston Parks and Recreation Department's Alief Community Center, housed inside the facility, will offer a wide range of recreation programs for all ages. Programming will include: After-School Enrichment Program, Summer Enrichment Program, Teen Program, Senior Recreation and Leisure Program, Nature Program, Volunteer Program, Gymnasium, Fitness Room.

The Houston Parks and Recreation Department's outdoor park amenities will include a swimming pool where classes like Learn to Swim lessons, water aerobics, open swim, and lap swimming may be offered. There will be walking paths throughout the park with distance options. Active sports enthusiasts will have tennis courts, a basketball court, a skatepark, soccer fields, practice field, and futsal courts. Youth focused amenities include a playground, which includes a large climbing net structure and climbing wall that will be the first in the HPARD system. Passive and natural spaces will provide a place for the community to unwind.
